

**Minutes of a Regular Meeting

The comprehensive Grounds Subcommittee Report of January 28, 2022 was discussed. The replacement heads mentioned therein are new; fairways will be mowed to 1/2" during the summer; paint color being used is very attractive; cup interior walls would only be painted to match for special occasions.
