Rules of Golf

Rule 6.3c – Hitting the Wrong Ball

In Stroke Play, the player hitting another player's ball receives a **two-stroke penalty**. The ball is brought back by placing it where the ball was hit from, if the spot is not known, then as close as possible to where the golfer believes the ball was before it was hit.

In Match Play the penalty is **loss of hole**.
