After reviewing scoring data, the following changes to the women's 18 hole rankings-by-difficulty list were suggested by the Greens Committee and recently approved by Mike Jahaske and the Board of SBRWGA. These changes will be reflected in both GHIN and Golf Genius. On the front nine, holes #1 and #4 (current difficulty rankings of 2 and 4) are now re-ranked to 4 and 2. On the back nine, holes #15 and #17 (current difficulty rankings of 9 and 11) are re-ranked to 11 and 9. All other rankings remain the same.

### **Rules News**

You'll find Landscaped Areas on every SBR hole except #4, 6 and 8. They are recognizable by the pea-sized gravel and attractively placed shrubbery.

SBR Local Rules require you to take FREE Relief from the Landscaped Area, one club length from the nearest point of complete relief (stance, swing and lie), no nearer the hole.
