Rule 1.2 (found on page one!) of the *R&A USGA Official Guide to the Rules of Golf* introduces the idea of sportsmanship while playing golf and directs players to:

- 1.2.a Act with integrity in applying Rules and penalties to themselves;
- 1.2.b Show consideration to others by playing at a prompt pace, observing safe behavior, and not distracting another player; and
- 1.2.c Take good care of the course.

SBRWGA enjoys a growing membership, and often you are paired with players you haven't met or see seldom. Basic etiquette and the Rules of Golf, indicate that you bring dignity, integrity, confidence and camaraderie to your 18 hole games. Being informed and responsible for yourself will assure that you and others in your foursome will enjoy the day to the maximum. If you aren't sure of a Rule, ask; keep conversations cordial and non-disruptive; don't litter and repair your divots.
