Proposed By Law Change

- Current language:
Non-members are not eligible for rights extended to members, including but not limited to special rates. Individuals may participate in SBRWGA events as a guest twice during the calendar year.
- Proposed additional language:
The exception to this rule will be for those individuals desiring to become members that are prevented from doing so due to the AGA website prohibiting new member sign ups. These individuals may play as a guest until the website allows them to become a member.



Overseed Plan

Fairways:

- **The goal** is to have fairways with a thick enough cover of turf that if left dormant for the winter, the turf will still provide a good playing surface
- Leaving 10 fairways dormant this year
- Plan to have all fairways dense enough to be left dormant next year

Greens:

- Our Greens are Tif Dwarf Bermuda
- **Three different grasses**, Rye, Bent and Poa Trivialis, have been used to overseed.
- Lifespan of Tif Dwarf Bermuda is nearing its end.
- Options for re-grassing are Mini Verde Ultra Dwarf Bermuda or Bent grass.
- Testing overseeding with Rye and Bent this year to see how it fares with our summer heat.

Practice Areas:

- Closed one week early. Range will open one week early with play from artificial tee area.
- Putting green will be overseeded with same as other greens
- Pitching green will be overseeded with Bent only.





Chelsea Pointing Policy

Points are determined by membership type (Annuals -½, Playcards-1, Residents-2)

Placement:

Points assessed by membership type at Placement (5 days before day of play).

Bookings:

Tee times made after placement up to the day of play. Same points assessed.

Replacement bookings:

When a person is added to replace another player after placement. Same points assessed.*

Walk Ons:

Spontaneous booking made on the *day of play*. No points.*

Guests:

Resident with guest bookings receive 3 points. If the guest is a legitimate guest, the points may be removed upon request to the Golf Professional.

No Shows:

Does not show or call on the day of play. 2 points assessed. Calls will be evaluated by pro shop staff prior to assessing points. *
