Rules Question:

A player's ball hits another player's ball <u>in the fairway</u>, are the balls returned to their original location or do you leave the balls where they lie? Answer: The balls are returned to their original location.

9.6 Ball Lifted or Moved by Outside Influence

If it is *known or virtually certain* that an *outside influence* (including another player in *stroke play* or another ball) lifted or *moved* a player's ball at rest:

- There is no penalty, and
- The ball must be *replaced* on its original spot (which if not known must be estimated) (see Rule 14.2).

This applies whether or not the player's ball has been found.

But if it is not *known or virtually certain* that the ball was lifted or *moved* by an *outside influence* and the ball is *lost*, the player must take *stroke-and-distance* relief under Rule 18.2.

Policies and Procedures Update

The Board reviews our Policies and Procedures annually for necessary updates. New this year is a Discipline Policy. The Board worked for several months on this new policy and after several revisions it was approved.

The following changes were approved by the Board at our last meeting:

- Solheim Cup to Updegraff Cup
- -Split the Rules Chair and Handicap Chair into two separate committees
- -SaddleBrooke Women's Classic rotate hosting annually
- -Member-Member change to two-day tournament
- -AGA State Medallion- if playing from Plum/Gold or Gold you can only qualify for the overall NET competition
- -Tee positions for League Days removed State Medallion and President's Cup from default PLUM tee
- *NEW Discipline Policy
