Tuesday League Day – Update

Throughout the year the Board has received several concerns from the membership regarding the Net Double Bogey rule played on Tuesday league days. Picking up for a Net Double Bogey score and still competing for the prize payouts in flights was not fair/equitable. A work group was formed to discuss this issue. The consensus was to change to the Maximum 10 Stroke rule previously used by the league. The Board approved the change to Maximum 10 Stroke rule at our November meeting. Effective January 1, 2024, players (on league day) will pick up for a Maximum Stroke of 10 for any given hole without being eliminated from the game. League Day chairs will continue to post your scores to GHIN per the World Handicap System (WHS) guidelines of Net Double Bogey. Our Policy and Procedures will be updated to reflect this change.

Rules of Handicapping Updated for 2024

The World Handicap system will be receiving a few minor adjustments to the Rules of Handicapping. Each of these updates are intended to make the WHS methods of Handicap index assignment and use even more equitable. Click the link below to preview the (4) main changes for use beginning in January.
