#### **World Handicap System**

The USGA will be releasing the updates to the WHS around January 16. Check your December USGA Handicap email for details on the changes to the WHS.

## The Never-ending Question: Am I Playing from the Correct Tees?

There are lots of ways to answer this question. Can I get on in regulation? Is my handicap consistent or creeping higher and higher? Do I rarely win in my flight? Am I just plain frustrated?

A common rule of thumb is to determine your correct tee boxes by how far you hit your driver. This guideline is even on the back of the SBR scorecard. However, many players have at least a 20 yard variance on their driver at any given point. The 7-Iron Solution may be a better gauge. Most of us know exactly how far we hit our 7-iron. It doesn't fluctuate much, does it? Recently in a USGA article the 7-Iron Solution parameters were described. Give it a try.
