GOLF COURSE OPERATIONS – M. Jahaske

Discussion at the meeting included:

- Embedded ball can be lift, clean, place.
- If the ball lands in the blue stake area, relief is available if the ball is within 10 paces of a drain or 2 clubs lengths from irrigation.
- Replacement sand for the remaining bunkers will be complete in 2026.
- Revisit garden area local rule to comply with USGA. Will schedule a meeting with all the golf clubs.
- A larger number of errant range balls near hole #1 possibly a risk to golfers on that hole. It is suggested that players park the golf carts on the cart path near the back side of the green.
- Players being hit by a golf ball (on any hole) should report the matter to M. Jahaske at the Pro Shop, so that proper documentation can be filed.

ACTION: N. Messner to communicate errant golf ball procedure on hole #1, and members must report if a golf ball hits them.
