Kathi is investigating a new bank for convenience and will also determine if this new bank could take Zelle payments, simplifying the collection of fees for SBRWGA events.

Handicap/Rules – D. Lawson

Deb provided the 3 key changes to the 2024 World Handicap System. These changes can be found usga.org/whs. The key changes are:



1. Course Rating & Shorter Courses

Courses as short as 750 yards for 9 holes and 1500 yards for 18 holes are eligible for Course Rating and Slope Rating – enhancing the portability of a Handicap Index.

2. 10-17-Hole Scores

Use of expected Score Differential applies when 10-17 holes are played. Introducing more flexibility to score posting when rounds are incomplete. In this scenario, you're asked to post your score hole by hole.

3. 9-Hole Scores

No more waiting on 9-hole scores to combine, they will count toward your Handicap Index the very next day. A premium is placed on the holes you played and combined with an expected Score Differential for consistency and fairness.

MEMBERSHIP – S. Ness

Susan reported that we have 108 members to start in 2024. She also discussed the SBR Club Expo and the value of having representation at this event. It was determined by the board that SBRWGA would not have a booth at the SBR Club Expo. Susan reported that the new member gift bag now contains scorecard clip boards.

WEBSITE – B. Simms

GOLF COURSE OPERATIONS – M. Jahaske

Mike discussed an email that he received from 2 SBRWGA members regarding frost delay. Mike acknowledged the strong desire of the members to keep our course in great shape and understood their concern. Mike works closely with Aaron, the golf course superintendent and encourages him to be conservative regarding preserving course conditions, erring on the side of frost delays or closures. Aaron takes many factors into account when determining frost delays: Air temperature, humidity, and air inversion. The white frost that golfers can see is not as bad as what is known as black frost which occurs when the ground temperatures do not warm and the soil under the turf is frozen leading to damage when disturbed by an object (golf ball, vehicle). Aaron has the experience and expertise needed to keep the integrity of our course through inclement weather, water breaks and assorted "off normal" conditions.
